

While the Lodge has been closed due to the COVID-19 outbreak, we have continued to do some much needed maintenance. Special Thanks to W.:M.: Ray Rios, W.: Rob Gibbons PM and J.C. Rogers for painting the outdoor exterior hallways. Assistance and labor from our members is a big savings in maintenance to our building, as well as a chance to fellowship and take pride in our Lodge. In case you were not aware, the Building Mailbox has been broken into three times and we are in the middle of replacing it. We have ordered an upgraded high end commercial multiunit mailbox for us and our tenants that will also have a gate affixed to it which will make breaking into it difficult. We also added upgraded lighting in the front parking lot, had an additional security cameras added to view the mailbox and front lots, and we have had landscaping done around the building.
