


Congratulations to Dallas Thomas and Robert Gawel who were balloted and elected by the Craft to receive the three Symbolic Degrees of Freemasonry.

#### Instructive Tongue

Most of us can understand that the newly initiated man would be called an Apprentice. But why an "Entered" Apprentice? Well, the word goes back to our operative days. The Freemasons of the middle ages were a select group, and were the highest class of artisans of their time. It required sound health, moral character, and high intelligence to be a good operative Freemason, permitted to work on the GREAT HOUSES of God, which were the Freemason's work. They were proud of their abilities, their reputation, and strict in their rules. To become a Freemason a young lad was required to serve a seven year apprenticeship before he might ask to be permitted to make and submit to his superiors his "Master's Piece", and be admitted as a "Fellow of The Craft." Before he could serve his time he had to prove himself; therefore he served a period of time as an Apprentice. If at the end of that period he had shown himself possessed of the necessary qualifications of industry, character, decency and probity, he was "entered" on the books of the Craft and became an "Entered Apprentice."

Originally an Apprentice was not a member of the Masonic Craft; not until he had passed his apprenticeship and been accepted as a fellow was he a Craftsman. Ritual teaches us that the Apprentice is a symbol of youth, the Fellow Craft of manhood, and the Master of old age; probably this conception is derived from the fact that learners and beginners are young, experts are men, and the wise and learned the elder group.
