Book Review by David Reilly, HPM *Hillbilly Elegy*, by J. D. Vance

Publisher Harper 2016

J. D. Vance is an Author, Politician, U.S. Senator -R (Ohio), and 2024 Vice-Presidential Candidate

His name is James David Vance and he was born in August, 1984 in the Hills of Kentucky. The book, Hillbilly Elegy has been referred to as a masterpiece in Appalachian life. The author being raised in the Appalachian Hills, coal mining, and poor, reveals his life growing up through the tough times when Coal Mining livelihood was being closed and the migration of the people moving north into southern Ohio, West Virginia and Indiana was occurring. He reports of his Scots Irish background, their ideals, ways of living and their law. He goes into detail of impoverishment and day-to-day living, the good that arises from it and the bad. He explains the how's and whys of politics in the Appalachians. He explains how he arose from the culture of family with siblings, and uncles, a mother that was on drugs and being raised by his grandparents. His book gives a decisive description of the life and times. He speaks of his math skills and that college was out of the question. He became a Marine and then went to college. He was fortunate enough to clerk in the courts and was introduced to law and politics. This book was written long before he became a Vice-Presidential Candidate, but he was serving in the U.S. Senate as a Senator from Ohio.

The book is excellent and at times the Appalachian Life draws and drags on a bit, but the point is to know and understand what has and is happening in the Hill Country, the people, and the towns.

Fast read and Recommended.
